**SECTION 2: LIMITATIONS**

**FLIGHT AND MANEUVER LIMITATIONS**

The helicopter has been substantiated for takeoffs in ambient temperatures up to +50°C.

In temperatures above +38°C, takeoff profile must be limited to 9 minutes maximum hover prior to initiating climb and 2 minutes maximum operation at any power setting above maximum continuous power.
